



Khmer Rouge Genocide Tour

Trip Overview:

This half-day tour takes in memorials and museums from Cambodia's recent history under the Khmer Rouge. An experienced guide will explain the significance of some key sites from during the regime's reign.

Tour highlights include:

- Toul Sleng genocide museum
- House and building use during the Khmer Rouge regime
- The killing field

What's Included: Experienced and licensed English-speaking tour guide, transport by air-con van, entry fee to Toul Sleng Genocide Museum and Killing Fields, bottle water.

Detailed Itinerary:

Beginning at 8 am, this half-day tour will collect you from your accommodation and proceed to Toul Sleng, the former high school that became known as Security Prison 21 under the Khmer Rouge regime, to discover more about this period of Cambodian history.

Later in the afternoon, you will travel a little out of the city to Choeung Ek, commonly referred to as the killing fields. This memorial marks the site of many mass executions by the Khmer Rouge and provides further insight into the country's recent history.
